Seems like the annual meeting and election of three new board members rolls around so very often, but it's nearing that time of year again. Cedar Blue needs candidates to run for those positions and will be accepting resumes for the election. If you believe in and want to work toward the betterment of the park, if you want to strive toward keeping CB a fun, safe & relaxing place to visit which we can proudly show off to the owners' family & friends, if you want to contribute, then we need candidates such as yourself to step up and volunteer to serve on the board.

Board members whose terms are expiring **September 6, 2009** are: Doug Meyer, Charles Freeman and Bryan Jackson. Those three (3) positions up for election are each for 3-year terms. The owner(s) of each property (lot) has one vote and must be in good standing with no outstanding debts or assessments to Cedar Blue in order to participate in the election. The election will be held **Sunday, September 6, 2009 at 1:00 p.m.** at the Family Center. Ballots will be mailed out around the first week of August along with candidate resumes. Any potential candidate should submit a brief resume to the Main Office by e-mailing it to: cbpoa@brightok.net no later than **Saturday, July 25, 2009**. Each resume needs to be presented as an attachment to an e-mail or on a disk so that it does not have to be re-typed. Resumes may be brief but should include:

- the candidate's relationship with Cedar Blue and lot(s) owned;
- verifiable primary residential address outside of Cedar Blue;
- how long candidate has owned property in Cedar Blue park;
- summary of candidate's work history or special qualifications that might prove beneficial to serving on the board of directors;
- personal statement of candidate's incentive for serving on the board, goals. Importantly, this is an opportunity to give voters an idea of what vision the candidate has for:
 - o present and future administration and operation of Cedar Blue;
 - o what changes (if any) or improvements candidate would like to promote;
 - o what Cedar Blue means to them personally.

Not required, but helpful information for the voting membership, would be a brief summary of family, hobbies, special interests. So often, we're familiar with people's faces, but maybe not their names, so candidates may submit a photo with their resume.
