10:00 a.m. - 11:30 a.m. Golf Cart Parade

Decorated golf carts and participants gather around the Family Center (not at the ball field) at 9:30 a.m. Line up behind the fire truck. Bring your prizes or candies to toss out to the spectators along the sidelines. Parade begins promptly at 10:00 a.m. - goes to all subdivisions except Deerpath - does not go down every street. Parade ends surrounding Family Center. 1st, 2nd & 3rd Place Prizes plus a Special Drawing for the Bonus Prize. Parade captains are Joy Carinder and Bruce Arnold. Theme is "Red, White & Cedar Blue". Wear and display your patriotism proudly. Bring your cameras!

REMEMBER: IF YOU OR YOUR FAMILY MEMBERS OR GUESTS SHOOT OFF FIREWORKS ON THE 4TH, THEN YOU ARE EXPECTED TO SHOW UP AT THE BALL FIELD EARLY THE NEXT MORNING FOR CLEANUP. PLEASE BRING YOUR RAKE AND SOME TRASH BAGS. 8:00 A.M. IS THE RECOMMENDED TIME FOR CLEANUP TO BEGIN.
