Swimming Pool Rules

WARNING – NO LIFE GUARD ON DUTY !

Children under 14 MUST be accompanied and supervised by parents or an adult.

Shower before entering pool. No food or drinks in pool area.

No glass containers, i.e. shampoo. Sunscreen should be in plastic containers.

No street clothes may be worn in the pool. Wear only bathing suits. No street shorts will be allowed.

All infants and toddlers not potty trained are required to wear swim diapers. The parasite, Cryptosporidia, and E-Coli 0157 are major health concerns at pools. In case of a fecal deposit in the pool that is loose or a result of diarrhea, the pool will be closed for treatment and will remain closed until water tests indicate it is safe to re-open.

Persons with cuts, sores, poison ivy and chickenpox are prohibited from entering the pool.

No animals are allowed in the pool area.

No diving, no running on pool deck. No one may throw or place stones, debris, refuse or discarded substances or articles of any kind in the swim area or willfully pollute the water in the pool. No rough play will be tolerated.

Stay off the rope dividing the pool. If the rope is down, the Health Department can permanently close the pool.

**Violation of these rules may result in permanent
disbarment from the swimming pool.**
